
THINGS TO BRING

GENERAL RULES



Welcome to this year's SMA International Summer Music School. We have complied this booklet to help you get around the course and campus as easily as possible. We hope you have a fantastic week!

- No Food or Drink in Classrooms
- No Smoking on Site
- Litter to be placed in Bins
- Noise levels to be reduced at 9pm, lights out 9pm promptly
- Toilet roll must be flushed down the toilet and not placed in Sanitary Bins
- Sanitary items to be placed in bins provided and NOT down toilets
- Laundry service is available at £15/bag. Each garment MUST be labelled with students/staff name and placed in laundry bags for collection. Return next day
- Any accidents with bedding please strip the bed and we will replace it as necessary there will also be spare bedding on each house should you need to change bedding in the middle of the night.
- Access into/out of Main house bedrooms must be by the side wing stairs NOT the main staircase.
- Please ensure that after your group has locked up and secured in the house each evening students/staff do not exit the doors.
- Door alarms that require silencing throughout the night will be chargeable Therefore will be turned off unless requested to be on.
- Smoke/Fire alarms and extinguishers that are activated in a non-emergency situation will attract a £50 fine
- Students should clear their table and place the tray and crockery on the silver shelving in the wash up area at the end of the dining room.
- NO sellotape or parcel tape to be used ANYWHERE around the site, please put posters/notices up with blue tack only.
- No writing/drawing on bedroom notice boards, these cost £75 to replace and any damage will be chargeable.
- Please respect our residents on site, who all live in the houses you are residing.
 Keep noise to a minimum and do not use their personal gardens as a play area.
- Accidents/incidents/near misses must be reported to **Linna (07765224168)** as soon as practically possible for action



VISITORS

Weekend visitors will mostly be accommodated in the same House as their family members attending the course but some will be in other houses. On arrival all visitors are requested to sign in by collecting their badge from the Office located in the Music School. We request you to wear as part of our security arrangements.

SATURDAY DEPARTURE

There are no lessons on Saturday - but there are lots of solo concerts, please check the posters in the Music School Hall.

- Please return anything you have borrowed from school
- All families should vacate the school by 2pm apart from the students who are one 10 days course
- The students who are doing 10 days course also need to pack your luggage as you might be relocated to a different bedroom.

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
